THE HAINES LINE

The Haines Genealogy is well documented and readily available in most libraries for all to see. We will note here only the line that directly leads to the Hinelines, starting with Richard Haines and Margaret of Aynhoe, England.

- 1. RICHARD HAINES (1) was the progenitor of the Haines family in Burlington County, although he did not survive the voyage to America from England in 1682. He and his wife Margaret were married sometime prior to 1665 and were affiliated with St. Michael's Church, Aynhoe, Northamptonshire, where parish records show the baptism of their son, John on 6 Aug 1665. Richard and Margaret became members of the Society of Friends sometime between 1672 and 1676. Their decision to make passage for America was likely influenced by their religious association. They had six children, five born in England and the youngest born during the voyage to America:

Richard was a farmer and owned a considerable amount of land in Burlington County, with purchases of 100 acres each in 1693, 1695 and 1700. He was also one of the purchasers of the "Friendship Tract," 2,240 acres of farm and wood land in the Southern Part of New Jersey, in 1711. He married Mary Carlile, said to have been an Indian maiden, -OR- said to have been b.20 Jul 1674 in London, dau of John Carlile and Mary Goodwin. The marriage date of Richard and Mary is not recorded but is believed to be about 1696. They had ten children:

- 8. Abram (3) Haines, b. abt. 1696; d. 1758, son of Richard Haines and Mary Carlile. Abram was a prosperous farmer, owning large tracts of land in Burlington County and Frederick County, Virginia. The Virginia acreage was granted to Abram Haines in 1754 by Thomas Fairfax, Proprietor of the Northern Neck of Virginia. At the time of his death he owned at least 969 acres of land in Burlington County plus 882 acres in Virginia. On 14 May 1719 at Chester Meeting, Abram mar. He was a farmer and shoemaker, living in Evesham Twp., Burlington Co., N.J. and later in Upper Alloways Creek Twp., Salem Co., N.J. In 1752 mar. Elizabeth Roberts, b. 12 Jun 1733; d. 6 Jun 1769, dau of John Roberts and Mary Elkinton. Both are buried at the Friends Burial Ground near Mt. Laurel, N.J. They had six children:

Dr. Haines attended Swarthmore College, and graduated from University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine in 1890. He was a resident at Cooper Hospital, Camden, N.J. until 1891 before going into general practice. He resided at 300 Kaighn Avenue (3rd & Kaighn Avenue), Camden, NJ, where he also operated a pharmacy and his practice. He purchased the pharmacy from Dr. Harry H. Davis. According to the book, "History Medical Profession Camden County," published 1896, Dr. Haines was licensed by the State Board of Medical Examiners in 1891.* He was active in Camden Lodge #15, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, and Camden County Medical Society. As owner of one of the first automobiles in Camden, he was active in the Camden Co. Physicians Motor Club, which worked for better

streets and roads and obtained the use of Red Cross tags to allow speeding to emergency cases. Dr. Haines retired in 1923 and lived at 503 Cedar Avenue, Pitman, NJ. In addition, he owned a home in Miami, FL. On 25 Oct. 1895, mar. Mary Anne Wilson, b. 1873 in Wilmington, DL.; d. 14 Feb 1904, bur Evergreen Cemetery, Camden, NJ, dau. of Henry Braid Wilson and Mary Ann Wilson (her own last name), with whom he had three children:

(William Amos Evans was known as the "father of the nickel sheet music", with offices in Boston & Chicago) Mr. Evans was quite successful, continuing to run the Evans Music Company until the early 1940's.
