
## AWFUL DOUBLE TRAGEDY IN THE HOME OF A CAMDEN BRIDE

Delaware Thompson, 28 years old, of West Chester, Pa., formerly of 716 South Eighth street, Camden, shot and killed Miss Adde Hacker, aged 23 years, of Littz. Pa., a peally beautiful grl, in the second-story front room of the home of his sister, Mrs. K. S. Lewis, at 534 Trenton avenue, Camden, shortly before noon yesterday.
