

Alleged Strike Ringleader Jailed

Accused of being one of the ringleaders of the recent disturbances at the New York Shipbuilding plant in Camden in which men on a strike are alleged to have attacked workers, Nicholas Mehalac, aged 21, of 1743 Van Buren street, was committed to jail by Recorder Stackhouse in Camden yesterday in default of bail. He was specifically charged with assault on James Mescil, of 1826 South Fourth street. The latter was attacked as he was leaving the shipyard. Mehalac is said to be one of several young hotheads whose radical measures have not been countenanced by the major portion of the strikers.
