

HUNTING FOR HIS SISTER

They Were Separated When Children, Eighteen Years Ago

George M. Farrell, of 1812 Van Buren street, Camden, is seeking information of the whereabouts of his sister, Mary A. Farrell, from whom he has not heard for over eighteen years. Their father died when they were little children, and at the age of 5 years the girl was adopted by the family of Zachariah Dellinger, who worked in a rolling mill in Bristol, Pa. This was in 1880, and a short time afterwards Dellinger moved to Wilmington, Del.

An older sister of Mary saw her in Wilmington when she was about 10 years old. The Dellinger family soon afterward moved to Philadelphia, since which time Farrell has lost all trace of his sister. It is presumed that she has adopted the name of her foster parents.
