

ATHLETICS VS. PHILA. GIANTS

Annual Game to Be Played on the Camden Grounds

The last game for Connie Mack's Athletics this season will be their annual contest with the Philadelphia Giants Saturday a week, on the Twelfth Street Ball Park in Camden. It will be the third meeting between these two clubs, and the colored champions have still to make a run against the American Leagueers.
