FIREMAN SLAYER SENTENCED Negro Goes to State Prison Twenty-five Years Clem Ridgway, the negro who slashed

to death former City Fireman Herbert Hibbs early last Chirstmas morning, was sentenced to twenty-five years in State Prison by Supreme Court Justice Garrison in Camden restorday. He entared a plea of non vult. The tragedy occurred while Hibbs was

on his way home with some presents for his children. There was a fracas at Seventh and Baxter streets while Hibbs was passing. He tried to pacify the disputants but his efforts resulted in him

being nearly decapitated by Ridgway, who used a knife. With his present clutched in his arms, Hibbs sank to the

pavement dead.
