

LONG RIDE WITH PRISONER

Camden Detectives Bring Alleged Murderer From Los Angeles

County Detectives Smith and Cherry arrived in Camden last night from Los Angeles, Cal., with Giovanni Cancelli, the Italian who is wanted for shooting to death Dominick Mercurio, a fellow countryman. The murder occurred last April at Fish House, and resulted from a quarrel over the possession of five cents. It was one of the longest trips ever made by Camden county officials after a prisoner. The detectives left Camden on November 4 and traveled nearly 7000 miles. Cancelli was safely landed in the county jail. He has already been indicted.

Court Officer Voigt also returned last night from Worcester, Mass., with Frank Millet. The latter is wanted on the charge of wife desertion.
