

A WRIT FOR LAMBERT.

Legal Battle for the Murderer's Life to Be Renewed.

Lawyer John L. Semple was successful yesterday in his appeal to the New Jersey Supreme Court for a writ of habeas corpus for Theodore Lambert, the murderer of Baker William G. Kalrer, of Camden. He claimed that Governor Werts had no right to issue a death warrant ordering Lambert to be executed on June 27. The writ is made returnable next Monday and was served on the Attorney-General.

Lawyer Semple complains that United States Supreme Court Justice Shiras' order directing the Sheriff of Camden county to stay the execution "until the further order of the court" has never been revoked. He will raise the point that Lambert must be re-sentenced by the New Jersey Supreme Court, and he is still confident of saving his client from the gallows.
