

No Indictment Against Staley

When the Camden grand jury filed a list of twenty-two true bills yesterday afternoon it was found that no indictment was found against Lanneaus Staley, one of the three youths connected with the murder of Karl Kellman last Sunday morning. An indictment charged Frank Coursey and Harry Duffield with the crime. Staley was present when the highway robbery, which resulted in murder, was planned, but the undisputed evidence is that he weakened and turned back before they reached the scene of the hold-up and shooting.
