

Praise Motion Picture Censorship

Camden men of prominence are sending letters commending Prosecutor Boyle and Mayor Ellis in their expressed intention of exercising some censorship over the moving pictures which came about as a result of Frederick Coursey, recently convicted of the murder of Karl Kellman, declaring, a Wild West picture was the incentive for his crime. Yesterday Rev. Samuel D. Price, pastor of the Calvary Presbyterian Church, and one of the most prominent of that denomination in South Jersey, sent a letter to the Mayor expressing his gratification over the proposed censorship. He urges that City Council adopt an ordinance prohibiting the showing of such pictures as show crime in any way.
