

YOUNG WOODWARD INDICTED BY JURY

He Is Charged With Robbery
and Murder in the Bill Pre-
sented to Judge Garrison

Two indictments against Paul Woodward, charging him with the murder of John Coffin and W. Price Jennings, the two boys whose bodies were found in a field near Haddon Heights, October-4, were presented before Judge Garrison in Camden yesterday by the grand jury. In the indictments it is charged that Woodward caused the boys' deaths by administering strychnine. The motive for the crime is charged in the indictment as robbery.

Following the presentment by the grand jury Judge Garrison heard argument on the writ of habeas corpus obtained by Woodward's counsel last Tuesday. At the conclusion Judge Garrison announced that he considered the two indictments sufficient to warrant the court in refusing bail. He then declined to make an order for Woodward's release on bail.

Wednesday, November 12, was set down as the date for the trial.
