

BACK FROM ITALY, JAILED

Suspect Fled From Camden After Stabbing Fellow-Countryman

Fleeing to Italy in June of last year, following a fight over a game of cards, in which Giacchino Bravato, of 349 Division street, Camden, was so badly slashed with a stiletto that for a time it was feared he would die, Saverio Monsato was captured in Camden yesterday by Policeman Troncone on a warrant charging him with having inflicted Bravato's injuries.

Although he told the police that he returned to this country last week, thinking the affair had been forgotten, Monsato pleaded not guilty to the charge when arraigned in Police Court. He was committed in default of bail.
