

SAYS HE SHOT HIMSELF. BUT POLICE ARREST FOUR

Following an investigation by Detective Troncone, the Camden police believe that Domenico Di Cristofaro, aged 25 years, of 1006 South Fourth street, who went to St. Agnes' Hospital, Philadelphia, with a bullet in his side Sunday afternoon, was not accidentally shot by himself, as he asserts. Four men are locked up in the Camden city jail to await further developments. They are Marco Giagamillo, Seraphono Di Vunato, Francisco Di Pietro and Canteloro Di Rocco, all of whom live at the same address with the man who was shot.

It is believed that one of the four accidentally shot the man while examining a revolver. Di Cristofaro had recently come to this country after serving fourteen months in the Tripolitan war, during which he was not wounded in the least way.
